REGIONAL COUNCIL APPROVES NEW STRUCTURE

With the transition of Pastor Tim Houston (Director of DelmarvaDC Urban Leadership Development) to Ohio last year, and the commitment of the churches to send an additional 1% of tithe to the office, the Regional Council appointed a task force (David Sulcer, Chair; Bill Reid, James Izzard, Billy Humphrey, Chris Lockemy, and J. C. Worley) to study our structure and make recommendations to better serve the churches and ministers. On January 27, 2017, the Regional Council approved the following REACH structure & 4-person team (each part-time or volunteer):

USA Missions/REACH Director - William A. Reid Urban Ministry and Benevolence Coorinator - Billy Humphrey Strategic Church Launch/Re-Launch Coordinator - J. C. Worley Hispanic Ministries Coordinator - Josè Torres

In the coming weeks the work and responsibilities of these leaders will take shape through various ministries each represent.

1% TITHE TO FOCUS ENTIRELY ON CHURCH PLANTING

In the June 28, 2016 ministers' meeting the following motion was adopted: "That we continue to send 1% tithe to the regional office for designated purposes." The discussion centered around utilizing the funds for church planting, ministerial training, and revitalization. The Council has carefully managed to assure compliance with these plans. In an effort to pinpoint precisely the intent of the ministers, the Regional Council adopted a plan that beginning September 1, 2017, 100% of the 1% tithe receipts go exclusively to church planting. You will be updated through this newsletter, our website and other means as to the success of your ongoing investment - particularly in church planting initiatives.
