Youth & Discipleship Administrative Assistant Jesus' words come to my mind today: If human fathers, who at best are imperfect and fallible, know how to give good gifts to their children, how much more shall the Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him (Matthew 7:11, paraphrase).

In plain words, the Savior was saying that there is no earthly counterpart to either the Father's goodness or His mercy.

Yet so few understand the Father-heart of God.

Jesus said, "[Father,] I have declared to them Your name [Your nature]" (John 17:26). The Gospel-writer writes of Jesus, "The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him" (John 1:18). In spite of these words there are still hosts of individuals who have no sense of inner certainty about the manner or the mentality of Father God. So many are dominated by the fearsome image of a stern-countenanced Deity, wielding His scepter in judgment. Yet the Scriptures reply in stark contrast, "Oh, give thanks to the God of heaven! For His mercy endures forever" (Psalm 136:26).

But God isn't Santa Claus either.

Neither is He "the Man Upstairs, " nor a syrupy, maudlin, super-grandpa who dodders around heaven in a semi-senile state doling out platitudes about "being nice," or, "anything is all right if you are sincere," or "love means you never have to say you're sorry."

He is a Father who teaches us, "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts" (Isaiah 55:9). In no uncertain terms, He shows us that His viewpoint and wisdom are so many rungs higher than ours, we're foolish unless we always . . .

. . . make Him our **point of reference** for counsel. He has the master plan of our life, and knowing the end from the beginning, is best prepared to lead us.

. . . trust Him with our destiny. Present trials, suffering, or tragedy may often seem the end - or cause us to wish it were. Yet the Father knows this period isn't the end of a sentence, but a connecting point in the completion of the masterpiece which is His whole story for us.

. . . wait for Him. What strange words. As though He were slow! But the slowness is our passage through time - time which He has already transcended. Mysteriously, He is able to both walk with us now, and be stationed at a point down life's road, waiting to welcome us.

In His presence we will be able to look back and say, "Oh, Father. I see. I see!"


APPLY FOR MIP AND CAMS BY JUNE 30, 2018
