Youth & Discipleship Administrative Assistant A few years ago a couple of minister friends decided to take up flying and enrolled in flight school. After getting their pilots license they insisted that I go up in a small plane with them. After they logged a few more hours I finally got up the nerve to risk it with one of them. One of the things that captivated me was watching my friend prepare for takeoff. After accounting for a list of about two dozen items, he calmly pulled back the stick, and we were airborne. It was a secure feeling to know that everything had been checked out!

Could it be that God is calling you to new heights of possibility in His purpose for you this day . . . this week . . . this season? Are you cleared for takeoff? If you're not sure, I recommend the following checklist to help you determine that you are "cleared" on these fundamental factors.

Checkpoint #1: Relationships

- Is all clutter of doubt, condemnation, or guilt between Jesus and myself cleared out? Is there a regular flow of one-to-one relationship with Him in prayer, communion, praise, and worship?
- Am I giving adequate attention to all family relationships? Am I faithfully giving
 myself to each member of the family? Allowing special time to be with each? Am I
 forgiving their shortcomings—and seeking their forgiveness for mine?
- Concerning those with whom I work or study: Am I sensitive as an available channel for ministry? What fresh flow of God's love might be released through me? Am I free of all resentment . . . lovelessness?

Checkpoint #2: Maturity

- Am I gaining new points of balance in my understanding? Am I giving God's Spirit opportunity to enlarge my awareness and perspective?
- How do I score in God's mind when it comes to such seemingly diverse principles as "Spirit-filled prayer life" and "fidelity with God's tithe"?
- Where have I been in my private reading and study of God's eternal Word? What points of truth have been opened or deepened in my mind?

Checkpoint #3: My church family

- Am I "in touch" with those things the Holy Spirit is saying to my congregation? Am I hearing Him? Responding? Am I simply part of the crowd, or am I a contributing part of the family?
- When have I last sought a new acquaintance at more than a surface level of involvement? Am I stagnating within a closing circle of fellowship, or open to and cultivating an expanding circle?

This list, of course, could expand considerably. In any case, take time with these. Only He knows what possibilities will open up for you as you climb to new altitudes in His purpose for your life.

GENERAL OVERSEER TIM HILL DISASTER RELIEF APPEALS

With storms ravaging southeast Texas, the eastern shore of the U.S. and the Caribbean, and the devastating earthquakes in Mexico, Dr. Tim Hill, General Overseer of the Church of God, calls on the church for prayer and support in a September 19, 2017 email:

"Our church family, facing the dual attack from Hurricanes Maria and Jose, needs our prayers today. Many who have already suffered from the devastating blow of a hurricane this season find themselves in the path of another storm in the next few hours. Like never before, they need our prayers.

"Our friends and family in the Caribbean, especially those in Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and Dominica, find themselves today in the eye of Hurricane Maria, with extremely dangerous winds and rain hitting those island nations. Already in recovery mode from the impact of Hurricane Irma just over a week ago, the storm surges predicted could be catastrophic, along with the wind gusts from the hurricane that now is classified as a Category 5 storm."

Dr. Hill's message regarding Mexico: "With hundreds feared dead and countless others injured, along with massive property damage, I am asking our church family to seek mercy and grace for those affected by the massive earthquake that hit Mexico City on Tuesday."

PASTOR OLIVER SUBRYAN RECEIVES CONGRESSIONAL LEADERSHIP AWARD

PRESS RELEASE: "US-based Guyanese and senior pastor of the Ebenezer Church of God, Bishop Oliver Subryan, is the first Guyanese to receive the International Distinguished Leadership Award at the United States Congressional Black Caucus (CBC) and Caribbean & African Leadership Awards Ceremony. The award will be presented by the United States Congress at the Caribbean & African Faith Based Leadership Conference (CAFBLC) on Saturday, September 23 in Washington D.C.

"CAFBLC has recognized Subryan's commitment and drive in promoting suicide prevention in Guyana, and his outstanding spiritual leadership, civic engagement and humanitarian services in the United States, Africa and the Caribbean region.

Subryan founded a non-profit NGO called HOPE, that is aimed at minimizing suicide in his home country. This followed the 2014 World Health Organization's findings that Guyana is among the top 10 most suicidal countries in the world, and has the highest suicide rate in the Caribbean."
