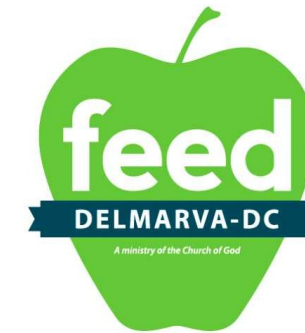

Feed Delmarva-DC Network and the Delmarva-DC's Urban Pastor's Network joined together to host Bruce Deel from City of Refuge Ministries (cityofrefugeatl.org) in Atlanta, GA for a time of training. Bruce took time from his busy schedule to train over 25 people from 17 churches on Benevolence and Care Ministries.



Bruce shared his personal journey of 19 years as an urban pastor and how the Lord has blessed and multiplied their ministry at City of Refuge in Atlanta and now other cities around the world. From a small after school program with 20 kids to an over 5 acres under roof ministry center with comprehensive services to families in need in the most disadvantaged zip code in Atlanta. City of Refuge now shelters women, women with children, and women who are victims of human trafficking. They have a culinary arts and auto mechanic job training center. And a full service health clinic on site. And an Early Childhood Daycare Center and a Middle-High School on site.

We are grateful for the wisdom and knowledge Bruce shared with our pastors and leaders regarding guiding principles and best practices in benevolence and care ministry in an urban ministry context. Special thanks to Bishop Rice for his help.

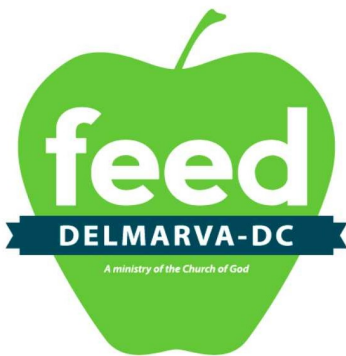
