To be bent back into shape tells us that the shape that we should be in is not the shape we are presently in. Therefore, we need to be put back into our original design. God has many ways of doing that. Scripture speaks of the refiners fire, the cleansing of vessels, grapes being crushed, wine being poured, wheat being sifted, olives being pressed, branches being pruned, gold being refined, and clay being molded. These are all ways God uses to prepare us for His purpose.

Too often, we have the natural tendency to aspire to levels of ministry that exceed our present level of maturity. When this happens, the result is an eventual train wreck. We want more than we are ready for.So, God lovingly begins His most important work and that is the work that He does IN us. Before God can ever do a significant work THROUGH you, He must first do a significant work IN you! We simply cannot ever stop growing, changing, or bending. It's not enough to just be called for ministry. You must also be approved for ministry and God has a special way of approving each of us for His service.

How is your spiritual shape? Do you need to be bent? Are you ready to be bent? I have a suspicion that your family, your ministry and your nation need you to be bent toward God. To paraphrase a much-used term attributed to Hippocrates, "desperate times call for desperate measures". Like the children of Samaria who were "besieged" and it caused a great famine in Samaria, we too are under siege. The end result of their "besiegement" was no harvest to draw from. The wine press became empty and the threshing floor became dry. They reverted to self-preservation by eating donkey's heads, doves dung and finally, each other (see 2 Kings 6). As you read the story, isn't it amazing that every time spiritual adults lose focus, children are always the ones to suffer the most?

What will be the end result of Satan's attempted besiegement upon us? If God can bend a man, He can surely bend a church and a nation. As in Wales, it begins with a MAN, through whom God brings about a MIRACLE, which will manifest into a MOVEMENT. Let's allow it to stop there. We no longer have the time for MONUMENTS and MAUSOLEUM.









DELMARVA-DC RENOVATES CHILDREN'S HOME COTTAGE

Dr. Walt and Tammie Mauldin announced that in the midst of the ongoing pandemic, a major renovation project has taken place on the campus of the Smoky Mountain Children's Home. Thanks to Bishop Stan Holder and First Lady Dr. Teresa Holder for raising \$125,000 to renovate Cottage 8 which is sponsored by the DelMarVa-DC region. Bishop Stan Holder serves as the Administrative Bishop in the DelMarVa-DC region. Dr. Teresa Holder is a member of the SMCH Board of Directors.

Teresa Holder visited the cottage along with some of her board members and immediately challenged the Women's Ministries of DelMarVa-DC to raise the funds. The cottage's renovations have included expansion of the layout from four to eight bedrooms. Each youth will now have their very own bedroom. Instead of two bathrooms, the residents will enjoy four full bathrooms. Another priority was to replace the existing walls with a concrete based drywall system, as well as install large fire coded windows complete with an updated security system, a totally renovated kitchen, and a commercial washer and dryer. In addition, a new roof was installed, and an interior window was placed in the caregiver's office.

Tammie Mauldin, Public Relations and Development Director, stated, "We were so excited to hear that Teresa Holder and the DelMarVa-DC Women's Ministries had set a generous fundraising goal for their cottage. This is the largest one-time gift by any state in several years! The Holders and her women's team really have a heart for The Home." Tammie and Teresa Holder first talked about the region's desire to do something significant for SMCH when Tammie spoke at their women's conference two years ago, but the region's plans were delayed due to Covid-19. Their fundraising goal has now been reached, and SMCH is so appreciative of this wonderful gesture.

Sevierville residents Ron and Betty Ogle oversaw the renovations and graciously committed to pay for any construction overages. In total, the project costs exceeded \$200,000. What a tremendous blessing the Ogles have been to SMCH!

Dr. Teresa Holder said, "We want to challenge other states to follow our lead. Every cottage on the campus needs to be updated. Our plan should serve as a model for other cottages to follow. We want our children and young people to live in a place that is just as nice as the home in which many of us live." She alluded to the fact that any state can participate. To be involved, it is not necessary for a particular state or region to be officially recognized as a "cottage sponsor." The future goal is for every cottage on the SMCH campus to be remodeled in the coming months, so SMCH welcomes everyone to join our fundraising efforts.







