New Hope Community Outreach Services Inc. (NHCOS) receives a \$74,360 grant from the Maryland Food Bank to continue their work in the community. This grant allows them to purchase a freezer truck and employ interpreters to better serve their diverse community.

This year, NHCOS has served over 6,500 families and 28,000 individuals. While open 6 days a week, NHCOS provides community assistance with Emergency Needs (i.e. food, clothing, baby essentials, adult diapers, hygiene supplies), Restorative Living (rental assistance/hotel placement), Workforce Development (computer training, job skills), Garden Education and Awareness, and Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking Education and Awareness.




